The petitioner-Rice Mill filed the instant writ petition seeking a Mandamus for directing the respondents to decide the claim of the petitioner for allotment of paddy for the 2017-2018 season.

In response to the writ petition a joint written statement of the District Controller, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Sangrur on behalf of respondents no.1 to 5 has been filed.

Appended with the reply at Annexure R-1 is an order dated 25.7.2018 passed by the Director, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab and whereby a view has been taken against the petitioner and by holding it to be ineligible for allotment of paddy at this stage.

In view of the above, instant writ petition is disposed of accordingly.

Liberty, however, is granted to the petitioner meanwhile to raise a challenge to the order dated 25.7.2018 (Annexure R-1), if, so advised and on grounds as may be available in accordance with law.

Disposed of.
