The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 6.5.2019 passed in CWP No. 11705 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above, without advertting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director, Panchayat- cum- Commissioner, Punjab to consider and decide the representation dated 18.4.2019 (Annexure P-4) in accordance with law within four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of four weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter."

There is nothing on record to show that certified copy of the order of this Court has been supplied to the respondents. Let copy be supplied to the respondents now.

In case needful is done, the respondents would atleast now realize that directions issued by this Court were time bound and will do the needful at the earliest.
