The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.74 dated 17.07.2019 under Section 3(2) of SC&ST Act and Section 66 of I.T. Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamunanagar.

The operative part of the order dated 27.08.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant is subordinate to the petitioner and on an earlier occasion, the petitioner has refused to grant leave to him and in order to take revenge, on a retirement party of another colleague, when both, the petitioner and the complainant, were having drinks, they entered into an altercation and thereafter, FIR has been registered, in which some members of Ambedkar Yuva Manch have also

signed, though they are not witness to the occurrence. It is further submitted that the FIR was registered after a delay of about 07 days.

Notice of motion for 25.09.2019....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 27.08.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Mehma Singh, assisted by counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 27.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
