Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of writ of habeas corpus.

On 22.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Sidakmeet Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State. A copy of complete paper-book be handed over to him during the course of the day.

Respondent No.3-SHO, Police Station Chnader, District Amritsar is directed to visit the house of private respondents No.4 and 5 and make enquiry as to whether detenue-Kirandeep Kaur is residing there with her own consent or has been detained by the private respondents illegally and forcibly. If respondent No.3-SHO finds that the detenue has been kept forcibly and against her wishes, then she be produced immediately before this Court. Otherwise, a detailed report be submitted on the date fixed.

Adjourned to 2.09.2019.

A copy of this order be given dasti to learned State counsel under the signatures of Bench Secretary of this Court.”

SHO, Police Station, Jhander, Amritsar-Rural has filed status report by way of affidavit.

The alleged detainee, who is present in the Court, claims that she is married wife of respondent No.4. Petitioner, who is father of alleged detainee, has been given opportunity to speak to the girl before lunch session. After speaking to the alleged detainee, the petitioner is satisfied that she has married with respondent No.4.

In view thereof, no further orders are required to be passed.
