Challenge in the instant writ petition is to the order dated 21.05.2018 (Annexure P-8) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka, whereby a representation preferred by the petitioner as regards an alleged encroachment having been made by respondent No.5 has been found to be incorrect and as such the representation has been rejected.

Counsel having argued the matter at some length prays for withdrawal of the writ petition so as to avail of any alternate civil remedy as per law that may be available to the petitioner.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

It is, however, made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the impugned order dated 21.05.2018 at Annexure P-8.
