The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 10.4.2019 passed in CWP No. 1029 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. The Managing Director, PUNBUS to examine the claim of the petitioners against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 04.06.2018 (Annexure P-5) and to take a final decision thereupon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It is clarified that this Court has not opined on the merits of the claim raised in the instant petition."

There is nothing on record to show that certified copy of the order of this Court has been supplied to the respondents. Let copy be supplied to the respondents now.

In case needful is done, the respondents should consider that directions issued by this Court were time bound and will do the needful at the earliest.
