The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.300 dated 24.12.2018, under Sections 323, 324, 325 341, 506 and 34 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and the injuries for which offence under Section 307 IPC has been added are attributed to co-accused Sanjiv Kumar, who is in custody.

This Court, by the order dated 28.08.2019, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dhanwant Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 28.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
