Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to direct respondent No.4 to take necessary action on the complaint.

A perusal of the complaint dated 29.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) reveals that complainant (petitioner) made a complaint against Harjit Singh who had spoken to her in a loud voice and she apprehended that he could have slapped her.

Considering the contents of complaint (Annexure P-1), this Court does not find commission of any cognizable offence. Resultantly, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
