Petitioner has made limited prayer for issuance of direction to the Executing Court to decide the execution petition at the earliest.

By referring to number of interlocutory orders passed by the Executing Court, learned counsel states that execution is being delayed for no good cause.

In a similar petition i.e. Civil Revision No.5188 of 2019 titled 'Raj Kumar vs State of Haryana and others', the Co-ordinate Bench has directed the Executing Court to decide the execution proceedings within a specified time by making all necessary endeavours.
