Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.175, dated 26.06.2019, registered under Section 15/25 of NDPS Act, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was not arrested at the spot and he has been nominated on the statement of co-accused. In fact, the petitioner has been falsely implicated.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, has submitted that the name of the petitioner was specifically mentioned in the secret information received and the petitioner was travelling in the same vehicle, however, on being stopped he had run away. Learned State counsel has also informed the Court that the petitioner has already been convicted in 2 more cases under NDPS Act vide judgments dated 21.10.2015 and 02.04.2012. He further submits that the petitioner is also involved in more criminal cases.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to grant concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
