Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to promote the petitioner notionally as Lecturer in Physical Education w.e.f. 24.06.2000, the date when her junior i.e. respondent No.4 was promoted.

Heard.

Reply on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 and 3 filed in the Court, is taken on record. As per the reply, necessary relief has been granted to the petitioner and she has been given deemed promotion as Lecturer in Physical Education w.e.f. 26.05.2000 vide order dated 28.12.2017.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that

arrears from the date of deemed promotion have not been paid.

As the principal relief has already be allowed, the petitioner is free to move representation for her prayer with regard to the remaining grievances, if so advised.
