AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

In pursuance to the order dated 29.10.2019, Dr. Anil Hooda, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest Department, Haryana is present in Court. State counsel on instructions submits that services of the petitioner (deceased) has been recommended for regularisation and the matter sent for sanctioning of diminishing cadre post. It is further submitted that services would be regularised, the arrears and even pensionary benefits as per rules would be calculated and paid within four months from today.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is disposed of.

The petitioners shall be at liberty to avail remedies available in accordance with law if aggrieved of the order passed with regard to the arrears and the pensionary benefits or the calculation of the amount due.

It is further clarified that in case the statement made today is not adhered to, the petitioners would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case the petitioners are forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting official(s).
