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AVNEESH JHINGAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioner filed CWP No. 11312 of 2019 for release of pensionary benefits and also eight months salary. It was claimed that approximately ₹16,00,000/- is due. The petition was disposed of on 1.5.2019. The respondents were directed to decide the representation dated 15.3.2019 and in case the petitioner was found entitled to monetary benefits, the same was to be released within a period of next two months.

The present petition is filed pleading that needful is not done.

Affidavit of respondent No. 3 filed in Court today is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for respondent No. 3 submits that an amount of ₹19,26,352/- for gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund and interest on delayed payment was paid and a sum of ₹4,94,808/- has already been paid to the petitioner for arrears of salary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that interest has not been awarded with regard to the delayed payment of salary and the amount of salary has not been correctly calculated.

The said aspect cannot be gone into in the present petition. There is no pleading to the said effect in the petition. Moreover, there is a substantial compliance of the directions of this Court, i.e. to decide the representation and thereafter to pay the monetary benefits. Speaking order dated 22.11.2019 has been passed and even the payments found due already made.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance.
