Short affidavit has been filed by State counsel in Court today,
which is taken on record.

Alongwith the affidavit, the re-employment certificate in favour of
the late husband of the petitioner(s) has been released by the petitioner(s) as
required by respondents No. 3 and 4.

Counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 states that though the case of
the petitioners for grant of the second family pension was complete in all
respect and petitioners were entitled for the same, but the same could not have
been granted without there being a re-employment certificate(s) from the State
of Punjab. Now, as the same has already been granted by the State of Punjab
and the copy of the same has also been given to the counsel for the petitioners
as well and also to the counsel for respondents No. 3 and 4.

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Counsel for respondents No.3 and 4 states that the case of the petitioner(s) shall be processed expeditiously for the grant of the relief as there is no other impediment now for the release of the same.

In view of the statement made on behalf of respondents No. 3 and 4, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) states that let an appropriate direction be issued to respondents No. 3 and 4 to decide the claim and pass an appropriate order granting the relief to the petitioner(s) within a specified time.

In view of the above, a direction is issued to respondents No. 3 and 4 to process the case of the petitioner(s) for grant of the second family pension expeditiously and pass final order granting the relief to the petitioner(s), as admitted by respondents No. 3 and 4 themselves in the preceding paragraph of this order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certificate copy of this order.

The writ petitions stand disposed of.
