Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 26.3.2019 (Annexure P-2) passed by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, in FIR No.220 dated 31.8.2017, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station City, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala whereby the bail bonds of the petitioner have been ordered to be cancelled.

Heard.

A perusal of the case file shows that the petitioner had applied and granted interim anticipatory bail by the Sessions Court vide order dated 06.5.2019 and was directed to appear before the trial Court. But, the petitioner failed to submit himself before the trial Court and vide order dated 23.5.2019 he was granted another seven days time to submit himself before the trial Court. However, despite that he failed to appear before the trial Court. Thereafter, the petitioner filed second application for anticipatory bail before the Sessions Court but the same was dismissed vide order dated 14.8.2019.

Considering the conduct of the petitioner that despite availing various effective opportunities, petitioner did not submit himself before the trial Court, therefore, no case is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

The petition is hereby dismissed.
