The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 71 dated 1.8.2019, registered under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120B IPC at Police Station Jhander, Amritsar Rural.

It is pointed out by the learned counsel for the State that there is positive material against the petitioner showing collusion in the crime. The petitioner had even collected the passports of the complainant by furnishing her aadhaar card to the courier company. Even those are required to be recovered, besides the other material.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
