Petitioner-husband has filed the present revision petition impugning the order dated 12.07.2019 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram, whereby his appeal against the order dated 06.09.2018 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram, was dismissed.

Vide order dated 06.09.2018, the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurugram directed the petitioner to pay Rs.20,000/- per month to the respondent-wife from the date of filing of the petition.

Aggrieved against the aforesaid order dated 06.09.2018, the petitioner filed a criminal appeal before the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram and vide order dated 12.07.2019, his appeal was also dismissed.

It is in the aforesaid circumstances, the petitioner-husband has filed the present revision petition impugning the orders of the courts below.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner and perused the case file.

As per the order passed by the learned Magistrate, the salary of the petitioner comes to Rs.65,143/- per month, whereas the respondent-wife has been granted interim maintenance of Rs.20,000/- per month. In any case, the awarded maintenance, which is interim in nature, is certainly not on higher side.

Accordingly, this Court does not find any cause for interference in the orders passed by the courts below.

Dismissed.
