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**MANOJ BAJAJ, J.**

Petitioner-Balwinder Singh has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.106 dated 27.08.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 148 read with Section 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 325, 326 and 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Chatiwind, District Amritsar.

On 27.08.2019, the following order was passed:-

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 23.5.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court in CRM-M-17900-2019, whereby the similarly situated co-accused Jaswinder Singh @ Sundri has been granted the concession of bail, who was also summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C.*

*Notice of motion for 22.10.2019.*

*Let the petitioner submit himself on or before 11.9.2019 before the trial Court. On his doing so, the trial Court*

*shall admit him on interim regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to its satisfaction.”*

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.08.2019, the petitioner submitted himself before the Court on 11.09.2019, who has been released on interim regular bail and had furnished the requisite bail bonds and surety bonds.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court on 11.09.2019 and furnished the bail bonds and surety bonds.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and petitioner is allowed to remain on the same bail bonds and surety bonds furnished by him before the trial Court on 11.09.2019.
