[1] Learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has produced copy of Order dated 06.09.2019, passed by the General Manager, Haryana State Transport, Delhi, as per which the petitioners, as well as other similarly situated trainees have been engaged as apprentices w.e.f. 06.09.2019 till 05.09.2020. Copy of order dated 06.09.2019 is taken on record and another copy thereof handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

[2] Learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, states that in the circumstances, the writ petition has become infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

[3] Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of Order dated 06.09.2019, he does not press the writ petition and the same may be disposed of at this stage, as not pressed, with liberty to seek revival of the writ petition, if cause survives.

[4] In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is ***disposed of*** as having become infructuous, with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same, if cause survives.
