Instant writ petition has been filed seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent/authorities under the State of Punjab to pay compensation to the tune of Rs.15 lakhs to the petitioner on account of death of her husband/Bhajan Singh which is stated to have taken place on account of an accident involving a stray animal on 05.05.2018 while proceeding from Chandimandir to his house in Village Amlala, Tehsil Derabassi, District Mohali.

Counsel representing the petitioner very fairly states that the petition involves certain questions of fact and which may not be adjudicated by this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

He accordingly prays for withdrawal of the writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail any other civil remedy in accordance with law.

Prayer is allowed.

Petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
