CRM No. 35391 of 2019 :

This is an application for correction of the head note and prayer clause of the main petition by adding Sections 325, 326 and 149 IPC.

Notice of the application was issued on 18.11.2019.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the application is allowed.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed. Sections 325, 326 and 149 IPC are permitted to be added in the head note and prayer clause of the petition. Registry is directed to make the necessary corrections in the petition.

Accordingly, interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 13.9.2019 is extended under Sections 325, 326 and 149 IPC also.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners has made a request to prepone the main case for disposal, which is fixed for 27.1.2020.

Learned State counsel has made no objection to the same.

In view of the no objection, main case is taken up on board today itself for disposal.

CRM-M No. 34808 of 2019 :

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 154 dated 11.6.2019, registered under Sections 307, 324, 323, 341, 506, 148, 325, 326 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim direction granted vide order dated 13.9.2019, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for the State, being instructed by ASI Sukhdev Singh, has not disputed the fact regarding petitioners' joining the investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 13.9.2019 is made absolute.
