Though, by way of CRM no.38487 of 2019, the prayer was for advancement of the date of hearing in the present case, today learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner no longer wishes to pursue the present petition itself.

It is to be noticed here that the learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is withdrawing the petition on the ground that there are 'talks' of a compromise going on.

What is further to be noticed however is that prayer in the petition is for the release of the petitioners' vehicle on 'sapurdari', with the orders passed by the trial court, rejecting that prayer, as also by the revision court, being challenged.
