Petitioner has approached this Court challenging the order dated 22.01.2016 (Annexure P-3), vide which, application for partition preferred by the petitioner has been rejected by the Assistant Collector 1st Grade.

Having considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties and keeping in view the admitted fact that the claim of the parties is not hereditary and both of them are purchasers of the property with their respective possession on the share of land as per the concerned sale deeds, the impugned order dated 22.01.2016 (Annexure P-3) does not suffer from any illegality.

The writ petition, therefore, stands dismissed.
