Counsel for the respondents has placed on record a compliance report by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh, IPS, Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar dated 15.02.2019.

Counsel for the respondents states that after consideration, the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been decided to be released w.e.f. 01.11.2002 till 30.09.2016.

Keeping in view the order passed by the Director General of Police in this regard on 12.02.2019. The relevant portion of the affidavit is as under:-

"1.That in compliance of the order dated 21.01.2019 passed by this Hon'ble High Court the pensionary benefits of the petitioner have been finalized and sanctioned to release the pension of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.11.2002 to 30.09.2016 vide order 2204-08/W-1 dated 12.02.2019 by the Director General of Police, Haryana, Panchkula. A true copy of the order dated 12.02.2019 is annexed herewith for kind perusal of this Hon'ble High

Court.

2. That vide office order No. 2204-08/W-1 dated 12.02.2019 from the office of Director General of Police, Haryana a copy of aforesaid order already been forwarded to the petitioner".

Counsel for the respondents states that the benefit for which the present writ petition was filed, have already been released to the petitioner.

As there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, the respondents are directed that order dated 12.02.2019 will be implemented within a period of two months from today and all the benefits for which the petitioner will be found entitled for in execution of the order dated 12.02.2019 will be released to him within the abovesaid period. Compliance report in this regard be submitted before this Court.

In case the petitioner find him entitled for any other relief than granted vide order dated 12.02.2019, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation. Respondents are further directed that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner, the respondents shall decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of two months from the receipt of the said representation.

The writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
