As agreed, as per statement of the learned counsel for Insurance Company, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹1,75,000/- (Rupees One lakh seventy five thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellants.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹1,75,000/- (Rupees One lakh seventy five thousand only) in the name of appellant No.1-Inderjit Kaur widow of Jaspal Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 30.01.2020 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Lok Adalat Branch shall inform the appellants-claimants in the Mobile No.8054971006 as and when the cheque is received.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
