Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to the Investigating Officer to complete the investigation and submit the *challan* in FIR No. 62 dated 20.03.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 201 of the IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Hisar.

Reply, by way of affidavit of DSP (Law & Order), Hisar, on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 4, is filed in Court today. As per reply, out of total 11 accused persons, 09 accused have been granted concession of anticipatory bail and they have joined investigation. It is further stated that one person, namely Ashok, was found innocent during investigation and one accused, namely Bhoop Singh, is absconding.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Kashmir Singh,

submits that *challan* against the aforesaid accused persons shall be presented before the Illaqua Magistrate within a period of six weeks from today. He further submits that the police is making all the efforts to arrest the accused who is absconding and will take further action in accordance with law.

In view of the above, no further action is called for in the present petition at this stage and the same is disposed of with a direction to official respondents to present the *challan* before the Illaqua Magistrate within a period of six weeks from today.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the petition in case the *challan* is not presented within the time stipulated.
