Prayer in the petition is to grant regular bail in FIR No.792, dated 26.07.2019, registered under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, at Police Station Jagadhri City, District Yamuna Nagar.

Petitioner claims to be a widow lady, having a small child. She claims that she was rather duped by someone else. Allegations against the petitioner are that she produced a forged appointment letter of Director Horticulture, Haryana, for appointment to the post of Peon in Group-D and on that basis she came to join.

Counsel for the State of Haryana has drawn attention of the Court to Annexure P-2, application submitted by the petitioner for registration of a case against Sanjay for extracting money from her with the promise to provide job.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh has submitted that the petitioner is not involved in any other case. He further submits that the investigating agency has sought one day remand which was granted and thereafter the petitioner is in judicial custody.

Case is triable by Magistrate. Petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019.

Without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 08.08.2019, not involved in any

other case and the trial of the case is likely to take a long time, the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of adequate surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly the petition is allowed with the aforesaid directions.
