Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the orders dated 01.11.2019 and 18.11.2019 passed by this Court stand duly complied with.

Affidavit dated 25.11.2019 of the Divisional Canal Officer, Eastern Canal Division, Canal Colony, Ferozepur, has been filed in Court mentioning that the demolished watercourse has been restored on 20.11.2019 after dismantling the *pucca* room, which was mentioned in the orders referred to above.

Counsel for the State contends that the writ petition, in the light of the compliance of the orders, has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

However, the canal authorities and the Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka, shall ensure that no encroachment is again made on the *khal*, which has been restored.
