Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that though in the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the order imposing punishment, by which his four increments were stopped, the appellate authority, prima-facie, has decided to modify the order of penalty but the said order has not been passed as the approval of the Punjab Public Service Commission is still awaited.

Learned counsel for the respondents assures this Court that an appropriate order will be passed and conveyed to the petitioner by the appellate authority in respect of the appeal preferred by him against the order of punishment within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, no further grievance of the petitioner subsists and he does not wish to press the present writ petition.

Writ petition is disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

In case, after passing of the order in appeal, it is found that petitioner is entitled for any relief, the same should also be extended to him within a period of three months thereafter.
