The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 6.5.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 11876 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, the respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 5.3.2019 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.”

As per order dated 6.5.2019, the respondent had to decide the legal notice dated 5.3.2019 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As per the averments made in the petition, copy of the order passed by this Court was sent to the respondent but there is no proof

attached. Let atleast now copy be supplied to the respondent and in case of

doing the needful, the respondent shall ensure compliance of the order dated 6.5.2019 within three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of non-compliance, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting official.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
