Petitioners seek a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty and by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondent no.4 to 7.

On the last date of hearing respondent no.3 had been directed to ensure the presence of petitioner no.1 in Court.

Petitioner no.1 namely Kanchan is present in Court and is identified by counsel representing the petitioners as also ASI Balvir Singh, P.S. Khuhian Sarwar, District Fazilka, who is present in Court.

This Court has interacted with petitioner no.1 Kanchan and who states her age to be 20 years. She has stated in Open Court that she wishes to proceed along with her father namely Subhash Chander, respondent no.4, who is also present in Court and of her own free will and accord.

In view of the above, no directions are required to be passed in the instant writ petition and the same is, accordingly, disposed of.

It is made clear that the filing of the instant petition as also disposal of the same would not preclude the respondent authorities to proceed further in the matter against petitioner no.2 in the eventuality of any complaint having been lodged.
