Prayer in the petition is to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.85 dated 21.08.2017 registered under Sections 21/29 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act at Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar.

Petitioner is an accused in the aforesaid case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been nominated on the statement of the co-accused and there is no recovery of narcotics or psychotropic substances from the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner was granted bail by the learned trial Court on 18.10.2017 and thereafter he had been regularly appearing before the Court. He further submits that the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on 29.04.2019 due to the fact that he was in custody in some other

case under Sections 107, 151 IPC. He submits that non-appearance of the petitioner was not intentional.

Learned counsel for the State, while drawing attention of the Court to the order passed by the Court of Sessions, submits that petitioner could not produce custody certificate in other case.

Be that as it may. Learned counsel for the petitioner undertakes that petitioner would surrender before the trial Court within 10 days and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.

Keeping in view the undertaking given, the present petition is disposed of by directing the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within 10 days from today and furnish fresh bail bonds with surety of like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

This order is conditional and would enure to the benefit of the petitioner only if the petitioner complies with the undertaking. Petitioner would also be required to file affidavit to the effect that he would not remain absent during the course of trial unless prior exemption from appearance has been granted.

Petition disposed of.
