This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 16.5.2019 passed in CWP No. 12929 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the relief claimed in the present writ petition or in the legal notice, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the legal notice dated 25.12.2018 (Annexure P-11) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of."

Learned counsel for the petitioner on realizing that no notice has been served upon the respondents after expiry of period granted by this Court, seeks permission to withdraw the present contempt petition at this stage with liberty to serve notice to the respondents. There is no doubt that in case needful is done, the respondent should consider the directions issued by this Court were time bound.
