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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 106, dated 11.8.2019, registered under Sections 61/78 of Punjab Excise Act, 1914 at Police Station Bareta, District Mansa.

As per allegations in FIR, 1200 bottles of country made liquor for sale in Haryana were recovered from one Puran Singh. The petitioner was escorting said truck, from which bottles of country made liquor were recovered in a separate car.

The learned counsel for petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. It is further contended that petitioner is not owner of said truck.

Vide order dated 27.8.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed petitioner to join investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Chamkaur Singh, states that petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of above, order dated 27.8.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner, is made absolute. However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
