Grievance of the petitioner herein is limited to the extent that despite the petitioner having participated in the selection process followed by an interview held on 06.08.2019, pursuant to the advertisement contained at Annexure P-1, he has been declared unfit due to his short height. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits the even though no formal intimation has been received by the petitioner from the respondents. But he has been verbally informed at the time of interview that he has been found disqualified on the ground of height, which upon measurement was found to be less than 165 cm. He submits that the petitioner is 165.5 cm tall as per medical certificate (Annexure P/4) issued by Dr. Gian Chand Rana, MBBS, MD.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Agam Jund, Advocate for Mr.Karan Kumar Jund, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of Union of India and states that no final order qua disqualification of the petitioner has been passed by the respondents so far.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the

respondents, no further proceedings and pleadings are required. Prima facie, I am of view that this writ petition is filed prematurely as there is no formal order of rejection of the candidature of petitioner, as has been contended by the petitioner.

The writ petition is disposed of with an observation that the respondents will declare the result of all the candidates, including petitioner who had participated in the selection process followed by an interview held on 06.08.2019, pursuant to the advertisement contained at (Annexure P-1) as expeditiously as possible.
