The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to conduct a fair and proper investigation in FIR No.203 dated 14.05.2019 under Sections 379-A, 376-D, 452 and 506 IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

Prayer has also been made for issuance of directions to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7 by deciding the representation dated 28.05.2019 (Annexure P-3) given to the respondent No.2.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusing the paper book, it reveals that the aforesaid FIR was registered by the police on 14.05.2019 against Shaukin son of the petitioner and Aashif, who is nephew of the petitioner on the basis of complaint made by Baskari wife of

respondent No.5 Sahood. Moreover, the son and nephew of the petitioner i.e. Shaukin and Aashif are already accused in another FIR No.73 dated 06.03.2019 under Sections 457 and 380 IPC registered at Police Station Naugawan, District Alwar.

Therefore, the plea of the petitioner that registration of the aforesaid FIR No.203 dated 14.05.2019 under Sections 379-A, 376-D, 452 and 506 IPC as well as Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 against her son and nephew is nothing but total abuse of process of law, cannot be accepted at this stage, particularly when the matter is being investigated by the police.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
