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This order will dispose of FAO No.1266 of 2014 (Mukhtiar Kaur Vs. Angrej Singh & Ors) and FAO No.8890-2014 (Sukhpreet Kaur & Anr. Vs. Mukhtiar Kaur & Ors).

Lakhwinder Singh son of Sh. Gurdas Singh died in a motor accident. Two claim petitions were filed one by Sukhpreet Kaur-wife of the deceased and her minor son-Ramandeep and other claim petition was filed by Mukhtiar Kaur-mother of the deceased. Two claim petitions were consolidated and were disposed of vide order dated 30.04.2013 by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. A total compensation of Rs.8,31,000/- was awarded out of which Rs.2,50,000/- was awarded to the mother and the rest Rs.5,81,000/- was awarded to the widow and the minor son (Rs.2,50,000/- to the widow and Rs.3,31,000/- for the minor child).

The matter was discussed in detail with learned counsel for the claimants in two appeals.

Learned counsel appearing for the claimants in the two appeals submitted that the claimants will feel satisfied if the compensation awarded by the learned Tribunal is enhanced by Rs.3,30,000/- and out of that compensation, a total of Rs.2,30,000/- be paid to Sukhpreet Kaur and her

minor son and the rest i.e. Rs.1,00,000/- to Mukhtiar Kaur, mother of the deceased, in full & final satisfaction of their claim. Mr. Gopal Mittal, learned Counsel for the Insurance Company agrees to the proposal.

In view of the above, both the appeals i.e. FAO No.1266 of 2014 (Mukhtiar Kaur Vs. Angrej Singh & Ors.) and FAO No.8890 of 2014 (Sukhpreet Kaur & Anr. Vs. Mukhtiar Kaur & Ors.) are disposed of. The enhanced amount of compensation in the sum of Rs.2,30,000/- be paid to Sukhpreet Kaur and her minor son (FAO No.8890 of 2014) and Rs.1,00,000/- to Mukhtiar Kaur, Mother of the deceased (FAO No.1266 of 2014). The Insurance Company shall deposit the two cheques as stated above with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 05.03.2019. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheques/drafts bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeals stand disposed of.
