[1] Prayer in the writ petition is for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing respondents to give promotion to the petitioner w.e.f. the date persons junior to her have been given promotion with all consequential benefits.

[2] Notice of motion was issued on 09.05.2016. On 28.02.2017, the petitioner was directed to furnish three sets of writ petition to the learned State Counsel during the course of day while respondents were directed to file statement of objections before the next date of hearing i.e. 12.05.2017. On 12.05.2017, learned State Counsel sought further time to file statement of objections. After said date, the case had been listed on four dates but could not be taken up for hearing. However, till today, no reply has been filed.

[3] At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has submitted representations Annexure P-6 and P-7 dated 06.07.2015 and 18.09.2015 respectively in respect of grievance which is the subject matter of the instant writ petition and that in the circumstances, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the said representations by passing speaking order in a stipulated period of time.

[4] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representations Annexure P6 dated 06.07.2015 and Annexure P-7 dated 18.09.2015 within one month from the date of submission of certified copy of the order. Needless to mention, in case the petitioner is aggrieved with the decision taken on her representations, she would be at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law.
