The petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR No.224, dated 16.09.2017, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that it is alleged by the complainant in the FIR that jewellery and other articles were stolen by some unknown persons from his house and the petitioners have been falsely implicated by the police. The petitioners are in custody for over two months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Harphool states that the petitioners have been put in column No.2 as they were found innocent during investigation and report in this regard has been filed in the Court.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners especially when the petitioners are in custody for over two months, the petitioners have been found innocent during investigation and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioners.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
