LISA GILL, J.

Present appeal has been filed by the claimants for enhancement of compensation awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Hisar (hereinafter referred to as the 'Tribunal') on account of death of Suraj Bhan vide award dated 31.07.2012 in a petition under Section 163A of the Motor Vehicles Act filed by the claimants.

Compensation was sought on account of death of Suraj Bhan in a motor vehicle accident, which took place on 24.07.2011 due to the use of motorcycle in question. Suraj Bhan was himself riding the motorcycle. Learned Tribunal on considering the facts and circumstances of the case awarded a sum of ₹1 lakh i.e. compulsory personal accident cover of the owner/driver.

None had been appearing on behalf of the appellants on various occasions and learned counsel for the appellants was directed to be notified of the date fixed in this case on 21.08.2018. Learned counsel for the appellants appeared on 30.11.2018 and sought an adjournment. He, however, did not appear on 04.12.2018 and again sought an adjournment on 11.04.2019. Thereafter, none appeared on behalf of the appellants on the

last date of hearing i.e. 09.05.2019 and the matter was adjourned for today.

Today again, there is no representation on behalf of the appellants. It appears that the appellants are not interested in pursuing the matter any longer.

Appeal is, accordingly, dismissed in default and for non-prosecution.
