Petitioner seeks bail in FIR No.173 dated 15.06.2006 registered under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Explosion Act, 1908 at Police Station, Division No.6, District Jalandhar.

Petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 11.09.2007. After a period of approximately 12 years, he has been arrested. As per the case of the prosecution, there are serious allegations of use of explosive substances. Petitioner is also involved in other criminal case under Section 302 IPC and Sections 3, 4 and 5 of the Explosion Act, 1908. Apart therefrom, there are more than four FIRs against the petitioner.

In view of the above, there is no ground to grant concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
