The appellants have filed CM-5218-CII-2014 for leading additional evidence qua the income of the deceased. Admittedly, the appellants were residing abroad.

Learned counsel for the respondent-Insurance Company has filed reply stating therein that the same cannot be read into evidence till such time they are proved.

In view of the same, this Court deems it proper to remand the matter back to the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurdaspur to take the additional evidence qua the income of the deceased with liberty to both the parties to lead their evidence in proof of the same and, thereafter, after recording findings qua it, the matter be sent back to the High Court.

Disposed of as above.
