The prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ of *Mandamus*, directing respondents No.2 & 3 to stop sending their recovery agents and musclemen who are stopping the vehicle Tip-trailer i.e. goods carrier of NP, of the petitioner on the borders of each state for their seizure and harassing the trucker to face such mental torture.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since certain disputed questions of fact are involved in this case, she may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court seeking redressal of the grievance as sought in the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
