On 29.08.2019, following order was passed by this Court:-

“Petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in FIR NO.32, dated 04.07.2018, registered under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC, at Police Station Sadar Anaj Mandi, Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was appointed as a representative in the company, assigned duty to appoint various distributors/agents for sale of chemical produced by the first informant company. He submits that the aforesaid agents/distributors had defaulted in payment, whereas the petitioner is sought to be implicated in the aforesaid case.

Notice of motion for 21.10.2019.

On asking of Court, Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State. A copy of the

petition be handed over to Mr. Bhupender Beniwal, AAG, Punjab, during the course of the day.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Sukha Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, the order dated 29.08.2019 is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
