This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 to decide the representation dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-6) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has been handed over to Mr. Vikas Mohan Gupta, Addl. AG Punjab, in the Court today.

In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Director, Rural Development and Panchayat Department, Mohali to consider and decide the representation dated 16.06.2019 (Annexure P-6) in accordance with law within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter, in accordance with law.
