Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 96, dated 12.6.2019, registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 379 B, 148, 149 IPC at P.S. Sarabha Nagar, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

The contention of learned counsel for petitioner is that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He has placed on record a compact disk containing CCTV footage which shows that petitioner is standing at a side and he was not involved in the incident.

Vide order dated 28.8.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 28.8.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
