Learned State counsel submits that the 'popular trees' do not belong to the Government and have not been planted by the Forest Department and grow on private land.

I find that the prayers (ii) and (iii) are incomprehensive. Neither the petitioner nor his counsel is present.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a fresh petition after amending the prayer clause, if he is aggrieved or not satisfied with this order.
