Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 120, dated 16.7.2019, registered under Section 420 IPC at P.S. City Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations in the FIR are that petitioner Chandni and her sister Pushpa alias Khushi had allured complainant and her friends to invest money in share market. Complainant and her friends invested an amount of Rs. 17,06,626/- at different intervals, but the petitioner and her sister instead of investing it in share market had invested said amount in their names with Fair Wealthy Commodity Broking Private Limited.

The learned counsel for petitioner states that matter is of civil nature and same has been amicably settled between the parties by way of compromise dated 17.8.2019 (Annexure-P-3).

Vide order dated 24.9.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioner to join the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of above, petition is allowed. The order dated 24.9.2019, granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
