Learned State counsel has placed on file the information supplied by the Superintendent, District Prison Karnal, showing that the petitioner was granted agricultural parole for 25 days and has surrendered back on 9.7.2019. In the present case, furlough for 3 weeks was declined vide impugned order dated 19.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) on the ground that there is danger to public order if the petitioner comes on furlough.

Considering that the petitioner has been released on agricultural parole, the impugned order dated 19.7.2018 (Annexure P-1) is set aside. The respondents are directed to re-consider the case of the petitioner for furlough considering that while granting agricultural parole, no such ground came in the way while passing of the order.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
