1. Learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab on instructions from Smt. Surjit Kaur, Deputy District Education Officer (EE), Mohali states that as per intimation received by the department on 29.03.2019, respondent No.5-Raman International Public School, already stands closed but in view of the stand of the petitioner that respondent No.5-School is functioning even as on date. Inspection would be carried out by the department and in case, respondent No.5-School is still functioning contrary to the undertaking given by Mr.Ramandeep Singh, Principal of the School, appropriate action in respect thereto would be taken in accordance with law within a period of four weeks. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

2. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.4-Director Education Officer-cum-District Project Director, Sarve Sikhia Abhiyan, Mohali to take action in terms of order No.SSA/RTE/2019/114, dated 29.03.2019 (Annexure P-5) in

accordance with law and to ensure that respondent No.5-School does not operate in violation of the provisions of law.

3. Needful be done within a period of four weeks from today.
